THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

**VILLAGE OF GREYNA; APPLICANT**

The following limits, terms, and conditions shall be complied with in connection with the construction of a temporary sewage sludge dewatering cell and the removal of sewage sludge from a wastewater treatment lagoon located on the SW 1/4 of Section 5-1-11 WPM with final disposal of the sewage sludge at a registered waste disposal ground:

1. The applicant shall construct and operate the temporary sludge dewatering cell in such a manner as to prevent seepage from affecting adjacent property.
2. The applicant shall remove all sewage sludge and other solids from the temporary sludge dewatering cell within 30 days and transport said material to a registered waste disposal ground in such a manner as to prevent leakage or spillage during transportation.
3. The applicant shall, after depositing the sewage sludge and other solids in the registered waste disposal ground, place an earthen cover with a minimum thickness of 15 centimeters on top of the sewage sludge and other solids.
4. The applicant shall, after the sewage sludge and other solids have been removed from the temporary dewatering cell, remove the temporary dikes and restore the dewatering area to its original state.
5. The applicant shall advise the Director when the project has been completed.
