In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

THE MANITOBA WILDLIFE FEDERATION: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a fish spawning enhancement project on Sturgeon Creek between the Assiniboine River and Grand Old Mill in the City of Winnipeg subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

Specifications, Limits, Terms and Conditions

- 1) The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated April 21, 1994.
- 2) The Licencee shall ensure that no instream construction activities associated with the Development occur between April 1 and June 30 of any year.
- 3) The Licencee shall protect erodible streambanks disturbed by construction with riprap and reseed exposed soil with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
- 4) The Licencee shall ensure that all used oil products and other regulated hazardous wastes generated by the machinery used in the construction of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with all applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.
- 5) The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.

REVOICATION

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
