THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

THE RAPID CITY AND DISTRICT WILDLIFE ASSOCIATION NO. 180:
"the Licence"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a bank stabilization and fish habitat enhancement project on the Little Saskatchewan River R/W 20-13-19E in the Rural Municipality of Saskatchewan subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated May 6, 1994.
2. The Licencee shall protect erodible streambanks disturbed by construction with riprap and reseed exposed soil with a mixture of native or introduced grasses or legumes.
3. The Licencee shall ensure that all waste oil products generated by the machinery used in the construction and operation of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislative requirements.
4. The Licencee shall ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction and operation of the Development shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.

REVOCATION

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
