THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

**THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF

the "Licencee"**

for the construction of the Development being the relocation of a section of the Lake St. George Main Market Road from NE corner of Section 36-28-1W to SE corner of SW 1/4 Section 25-28-1W subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:


SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal, *Proposed Upgrading of Lake St. George Main Market Road in the Interlake Electoral Division Unorganized Territory*, dated October 6, 1995.
2. The Licencee shall, prior to construction, notify the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources Regional Office in Gimli of any ditching or drainage improvements associated with the Development that could affect the area's wetlands or habitat.
3. The Licencee shall, two weeks prior to start of any construction, notify the Director of the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources Central Region and Manitoba Environment Director of the Eastern-Interlake Region of the anticipated construction schedule.
4. The Licencee shall, from May 1 to July 1 of each year during construction, cease any construction activities that may impact upon the wildlife breeding and rearing season.
5. The Licencee shall, during construction, ensure that any fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 meters away from waterbodies including wetlands and shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.

6. The Licencee shall, during the full term of the construction of the Development, cleanup and deposit all debris from the construction site at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit pursuant to the *Manitoba Waste Disposal Ground Regulation, Manitoba Regulation, 150/91*.

REVOCATION

If in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not or is not complying with the specifications, limits, terms and conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
