In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

THE TOWN OF LEAF RAPIDS: "the Licencee"

for the construction and operation of the Development being a rockfill outlet control structure at the outlet of Turnbull Lake in 34-85-17W in the Town of Leaf Rapids subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Environment Act Proposal dated April 10, 1995, and additional information submitted in a letter to Manitoba Environment dated January 4, 1996.
2. The Licencee shall obtain access to the site for the construction of the Development using an ice crossing of the lake. Land access to the site shall not be provided.
3. The Licencee shall obtain a Work Permit for the Development from the Manitoba Natural Resources office in Leaf Rapids prior to undertaking construction activities.
4. The Licencee shall contact the Regional Fisheries Manager of Manitoba Natural Resources in Thompson with respect to the development of a fisheries monitoring plan for the Development prior to undertaking construction activities.
5. The Licencee shall not undertake construction or maintenance activities associated with the Development in May, June, September, October or November of any year.
6. The Licencee shall ensure that material used in the construction and maintenance of the Development does not contain fine materials which could erode out of the rockfill and deposit sediment in Turnbull Lake or the Opuskowin River.
7. The Licencee shall ensure that all used oil products and other regulated hazardous wastes generated by the machinery used in the construction and maintenance of the Development are collected and disposed of in accordance with applicable Manitoba Environment and legislation requirements.

8. The Licencee shall ensure that fuel storage areas established for the construction of the Development are located a minimum distance of 100 metres away from any waterbody, and shall comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.

REVOCAATION

If, in the opinion of the Director, the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke this Licence either temporarily or permanently.
