

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and CORDITE CONCRETE LTD., Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Cordite Concrete Ltd., submitted an application to The Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits in connection with the operation of a concrete batching plant located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7-12-5 EPM in the Rural Municipality of Springfield, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the said Commission by any person who is, or who is likely to be, affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;


AND WHEREAS the said Commission considered the application on the 24th day of March, 1975;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall ensure that solid particulate emissions from any process in the said operation do not exceed 0.57 grams per standard cubic meter calculated at 20 degrees Celsius and 760 millimetres of mercury (0.25 grains per standard cubic foot calculated at 68 degrees Fahrenheit and 30 inches of mercury), at the point of emission.
2. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of housekeeping and maintenance are carried out at all times in a manner consistent with meeting the limits prescribed in Clause 1.
