

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION  
 UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

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RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and the RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BLANSHARD,  
 Applicant,

- WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, the Rural Municipality of Blanshard filed a proposal with the Department of Mines, Resources and Environmental Management for the operation of a derelict vehicle and waste metal compound located on the road allowance between the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34-13-22 and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3-14-22 WPM in the Rural Municipality of Blanshard, Manitoba;
- AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the said proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;
- AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the said Commission by any person who is, or who is likely to be, affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;
- AND WHEREAS the said Commission considered the proposal on the 25th day of November, 1975;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall ensure that only derelict vehicles and other bulky metallic wastes such as farm machinery, household appliances and other large metallic objects are deposited in the said compound.
2. The Applicant shall ensure that derelict vehicles have been drained of gasoline and crank-case oil before being admitted to the compound.
3. The Applicant shall ensure that the derelict vehicles and other bulky metallic wastes deposited in the said compound are effectively screened from public view as approved by the Environmental Management Division of the Department of Mines, Resources and Environmental Management.

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4. The Applicant shall ensure that no open burning takes place within the said compound.
5. The Applicant shall ensure that the operation of the said compound is supervised:
  - (a) to ensure the orderly placement of derelict vehicles and other bulky metallic wastes;
  - (b) to control random dumping and littering of the area in the immediate vicinity of the said compound including the access road to the said compound; and
  - (c) to carry out the other requirements of this Order as these apply to the day-by-day operation of the said compound.
