

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and THE INTERLAKE POTATO FARMS,
Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, the Interlake Potato Farms submitted an application to The Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits in connection with the operation of a potato washing and storage plant located in part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35-16-2 EPM in the Rural Municipality of Rockwood, Manitoba, with discharge of effluent to an unnamed intermittent watercourse;

AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the said Commission by any person who is, or who is likely to be, affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the said Commission considered the said application on the 26th day of January, 1976;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall, on or before the 31st day of July, 1976, submit to the Environmental Management Division of the said Department a plan or scheme for the construction of works or facilities for the treatment and/or storage of effluent aimed at meeting the limits prescribed in Clause 2 of this Order.
2. The Applicant shall ensure that, on and after the 1st day of January, 1978, the quality of the effluent from the said operation is such that:

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- 2. (a) the biochemical oxygen demand does not exceed 30 milligrams per litre; and
- (b) the suspended solids content does not exceed 30 milligrams per litre.

3. The Applicant shall ensure that the storage and handling of wastes from the said operation are carried out in such a manner as to minimize the release of offensive odours.
