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AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and WHITEHORSE ENTERPRISES LTD., Applicant,

- WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Mr. A. Scoular, on behalf of Glenorchie Enterprises Ltd., filed an application with the Department of Mines, Resources and Environmental Management in connection with the operation of an existing septic tank system located on Lot 37, Plan 5066, in the Rural Municipality of Cartier, Manitoba, and serving the Whitehorse Plains Trailer Park, later known as "Whitehorse Plains Mobile Home Park", with discharge of effluent to the Assiniboine River;
- AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a regulation under The Clean Environment Act, the said application was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;
- AND WHEREAS after giving notice of the application, the Commission issued Order No. 668 on the 3rd day of March, 1977, prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;
- AND WHEREAS the assets of Glenorchie Enterprises Ltd. were subsequently acquired by Whitehorse Enterprises Ltd.;
- AND WHEREAS on the 11th day of July, 1980, Whitehorse Enterprises Ltd. requested the variation of Order No. 668 to extend to the 28th day of February, 1981, the date prescribed in the order for compliance with limits on the quality of sewage effluent discharged from the said operation to the Assiniboine River;
- AND WHEREAS after giving notice, the Commission held a hearing in Winnipeg on the 2nd day of September, 1980, and issued varied Order No. 668VC on the 11th day of September, 1980, extending to the 28th day of February, 1981, the date prescribed for compliance with limits on the quality of the said effluent;
- AND WHEREAS on the 18th day of March, 1981, the Applicant requested the order be varied to further extend the date prescribed for compliance with limits on the quality of the said effluent to the 31st day of December, 1981;
- AND WHEREAS after giving notice, the Commission held a hearing in Winnipeg to consider the request for a further variation on the 27th day of April, 1981, and the said hearing was adjourned and reconvened on the 25th day of May, 1981, the 20th day of July, 1981, and the 21st day of September, 1981;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT ORDER NO. 667VC BE VARIED TO READ AS FOLLOWS

1. The Applicant shall, in the interim period until an improved or replacement sewage treatment system is in operation, operate the existing septic tank system to the satisfaction of and in accordance with directions issued by the Environmental Management Division of the Department of Consumer and Corporate Affairs and Environment.
2. On and after the 31st day of December, 1981, the Applicant shall not discharge sewage effluent from the site of the Whitehorse Plains Mobile Home Park where the organic content of the said effluent is, as indicated by the five-day biochemical oxygen demand, in excess of 30 milligrams per litre.
3. On and after the 31st day of December, 1981, the Applicant shall not discharge sewage effluent from the site of the Whitehorse Plains Mobile Home Park where the suspended solids content of the said effluent is in excess of 30 milligrams per litre.
4. On and after the 31st day of December, 1981, the Applicant shall not discharge sewage effluent from the site of the Whitehorse Plains Mobile Home Park where the fecal coliform content of the said effluent is, as indicated by the MPN index, in excess of 200 per 100 millilitres of sample.
5. Order No. 668VC as varied by the Commission is hereby designated as Order No. 668VCC.
