

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

Re: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and FRIENDLY FAMILY FARMS LTD.,
Applicant;

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Friendly Family Farms Ltd., filed an application with the Department in connection with an existing poultry processing plant located about 1.2 miles north of First Avenue on the west side of PTH No. 12 in Steinbach, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under The Clean Environment Act, the application was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;

AND WHEREAS representations were made to the Commission by persons who are likely to be affected by an order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said plant;

AND WHEREAS the Commission held a hearing in Steinbach on the 14th day of July, 1980;

AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the application on the 21st day of July, 1980;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

1. The Applicant shall limit the emission of odour from the said operation to such an extent that the said odour, when sampled at any point of impingement beyond the property line of the said plant is not detectable:
 - (a) within a residential or recreational area, when one volume of odourous air is diluted with one equal volume of odour-free air;
 - (b) within a commercial or industrial area, when one volume of odourous air is diluted with six equal volumes of odour-free air.
