AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION  
 UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

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RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and DUHA PRINTERS (WESTERN) LIMITED,  
 Applicant,

- WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Duha Printers (Western) Limited filed an application in connection with the operation of a plant for the production of plastic-covered stationery binders and lacquered display materials, the said plant having been established in 1966 and located on Lot 117, Block 5, Plan 17671, at or near 90 Second Avenue in Gimli, Manitoba;
- AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits, terms and conditions prescribed by a Regulation issued under the said Act, the application was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits, terms and conditions;
- AND WHEREAS after giving notice of the application, the Commission received a representation from a person who is likely to be affected by an order of the Commission prescribing limits, terms and conditions in connection with the said operation;
- AND WHEREAS the Commission held a hearing in Gimli, Manitoba, on the 9th day of March, 1981, to receive evidence and representations concerning the said operation;
- AND WHEREAS at the hearing, Mr. Emeric V. Duha, President, Duha Printers (Western) Limited, gave an undertaking on behalf of the Applicant to cause the construction of a new, enlarged, galvanized sheet metal stack to an overall stack height of eighteen feet and bring about an increase in the capacity of the exhaust fan, for the purpose of causing greater dilution and dissipation of plant odours;
- AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the application on the 27th day of April, 1981;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- Assigned to Assistant Air Pollution Officer May 1981*
1. The Applicant shall limit the emission of odours from the said operation to such an extent that, on and after the 1st day of January, 1982, the odour emanating from the said operation shall not be detectable at any point of impingement in a residential or commercial area when one volume of odorous air is diluted with six volumes of odour-free air.



2. The Applicant shall carry out the necessary alterations to plant and emission facilities and install the necessary equipment to ensure compliance with the limits prescribed in Clause 1 of this order.
3. The Applicant shall at all times maintain a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping practices consistent with meeting the limits prescribed in Clause 1 of this order.
