Manitoba Sustainable Development, Environmental Compliance and Enforcement has reviewed the Environment Act Proposal for land application of biosolids from the Gladstone Lagoon and has the following comments:

-the proposal states that soil sampling will be completed and the proposed biosolids application rate will be forwarded to MCWS for review. There should be a clause in the licence requiring this to be completed

-there appears to be a residence on SW 21-14-11 W that is not associated with the landowner of the proposed spread fields. Table 6.2 (page 26) includes buffer zones that will be adhered to for the spreading operations. This landowner should be contacted to address any concerns with the operation prior to spreading commencing.
