**RE: Keeyask Transmission Project – Decommissioning Plan**

The Keeyask Transmission Project *Environment Act* Licence 3106 clause 41 states, “The Licencee shall, prior to decommissioning of the Development, submit for approval of the Director, a decommissioning plan for the Development”. Manitoba Hydro plans to decommission the KR1 Tap that was built as part of the Keeyask Transmission Project. The primary function of this KR1 Tap was to provide back-up construction power for the Keeyask Project and as the Keeyask Project comes into service this 4.98km portion of the KR1 line is no longer required. Therefore, please find attached a Decommissioning Environmental Protection Plan (DEnvPP) for the KR1 Tap.

Please note salvage work is scheduled to begin in early March 2020. Therefore, a decision regarding approval is requested prior to March 1, 2020.
