

## Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

**MANITOBA HARVEST HEMP FOODS – FRESH HEMP FOODS LTD. - HEMP FOOD PRODUCTS MANUFACTURING FACILITY - FILE: 5793.00**

A proposal has been filed on behalf of Fresh Hemp Foods Ltd. for the continued operation of a hemp food products manufacturing facility at 69 and 79 Eagle Drive in Winnipeg, Manitoba. The facility produces hemp hearts (raw shelled hemp seed), hemp heart bites, hemp heart bars, hemp protein powder, hemp oil, and hemp beverage. The potential environmental effects of the development are related to noise, air emission and generation of liquid and solid waste.
