

Manitoba Infrastructure (MI) has reviewed the proposal under the *Environment Act* noted above and has the following concerns/comments associated with the proposed development:

- The proponent should be informed that, under the Highways Protection Act, any new, modified or relocated access connection onto a PTH will require a permit from Highway Traffic Board for PTH's (Including change in use). A permit may also be required for:
 - Any construction (above or below ground level) within 38.1 m (125 ft) of the right of way PTH 16, 45 & 83.
- The proponent should be informed that, under the Highways and Transportation Act, any new, modified or relocated access connection onto a PR will require a permit from Manitoba Infrastructure. A permit may also be required for:
 - Any construction (above or below ground level) within 38.1 m (125 ft) of the right of way of PR 264, PR 366, PR 476, PR 478 and PA 668 (03668010HU); or
 - Any plantings within 15.2 m (50 ft) from the edge of the right of way of PTH 16, PTH 45, PTH 83, PR 264, PR 366, PR 476, PR 478 and PA 668 (03668010HU); or
 - Discharge of water or other liquid materials into the ditch on PTH 16, PTH 45, PTH 83, PR 264, PR 366, PR 476, PR 478 and PA 668 (03668010HU).
- Where the proposed water lines will be within highway right-of-way along and across PTH 16, PTH 45, PTH 83, PR 366, PR 476, PR 478 and PA 668 (03668010HU) an underground utility agreement will be required.
