**RE: Environment Act Licence Suspension
Discharge of Somerset Wastewater Treatment Lagoon**

This letter acknowledges the request submitted by the Municipality of Lorne dated October 12, 2017, to commence discharge of effluent from the Somerset Wastewater Treatment Lagoon outside the discharge dates specified in Clean Environment Commission Order No: 813.

I am granting a suspension of Clause 2(f) of CEC Order No. 813 pursuant to Section 18(1) of The Environment Act, which allows you to proceed with the discharge of the secondary cell of the lagoon. The suspension authorizes discharge of wastewater during the period from October 16 to October 29, 2017, inclusive.

Please be advised that if weather conditions become unsuitable discharge must cease and authorization may be revoked. All other clauses in CEC Order No. 813 remain in effect.
