

# Flowing and High Water Levels in Manitoba Wells

This map is based on data collected by the Province of Manitoba, Groundwater Management Section under the authority of the Groundwater and Water Well Act. The maximum recorded water level and flowing artesian conditions were compiled for all wells located by section, quarter, parish lot or GPS coordinates.

Current conditions may not be as shown due to natural fluctuations in groundwater level. Appropriate precautions should be taken in planning well drilling or construction. Although extensive effort has been made to produce error free and complete data, all geographic information has limitations due to the scale, resolution, data and interpretation of the original source materials.

## Highest Recorded Water Level

- More than three metres above ground surface
- Between ground surface and three metres above ground surface or wells without water level data that are indicated to be flowing
- Between ground surface and three metres below ground surface
- More than three metres below ground surface

Land parcels not showing a classification do not have a recorded well water level associated.
