SLAVE FALLS GENERATING STATION – SHORT-TERM EXTENSION LICENCE

We request a five year Short-Term Extension Licence (STEL) for the Slave Falls Generating Station under the provisions of Section 92 of Water Power Regulation 25/88R. We have included a Short-Term Extension Report as supporting documentation and will continue to work with your Department to address this Water Power licence. This support document highlights the following key items:

- Project Components and Characteristics
- Water Power Licensing Requirements
- Monitoring Programs
- Community Involvement and System Upgrades/Studies

Manitoba Hydro operates the Slave Falls Generating Station in accordance with the Renewal Licence for the Development of Water Power at the Slave Falls site on the Winnipeg River. This licence is in effect until January 1, 2022.

Manitoba Hydro requested a Second Renewal Licence on September 12, 2017. Manitoba Hydro intends to submit the technical requirements for completing the Second Renewal Licence for Slave Falls Generating Station to Manitoba Conservation and Climate within the term of the STEL.
