Where to direct public concerns about animal welfare? Knowing who to call when you want to report an animal welfare concern is important. Knowing the difference between Animal Welfare Concerns versus Animal By-law Concerns is crucial for prompt service.

The table below lists the correct contact numbers based on your location and concerns.
