

# CROP DIAGNOSTIC SERVICES - INSECT/WEED IDENTIFICATION



**Fresh samples that are properly collected and shipped are needed for accurate identification.**

**High resolution pictures are acceptable (no guarantee of identification to species level).**

Weeds may be placed in a plastic bag (fresh) or pressed and dried and shipped immediately in a mailing container or cardboard box to prevent crushing. Do not include wet toweling. Insect samples should be placed in a hard container. Most samples will be diagnosed within a week of receipt. A completed copy of this form must be submitted with all samples.
