What education is required?

- Bachelor's degree or diploma in agriculture or plant science

- gather and interpret crop information
- make crop production recommendations to farmers
- build relationships with local farmers
- help with data evaluations about crop production
- provide training to farmers



What do they do?

Crop advisors work with farmers and make recommendations on plant growth and soil nutrition. They help farmers make decisions about fertilizer, seed type, plant health, and insect control.
