Notes	<p>The recommended <u>minimum</u> interval between doses is <u>at least</u> 6 months, but a dose of the updated formulation may be administered if it has been at least 3 months from any previous COVID-19 vaccine formulation.</p> <p>*If not previously immunized, individuals six months of age and older who are <b>moderately to severely immunocompromised</b> are eligible to receive <b>3 doses</b> of COVID-19 vaccine. The recommended interval between doses is 4-8 weeks. Health care providers may recommend a different immunization schedule based on a review of medical history and individual circumstances.
